

# RED ALERT

A high-tech escape room style game in which teams apply creative thinking to problem solving in a quest to stop a computer virus affecting their company and personal data.

## How it works

Teams watch a sinister video from a masked representative of the Red Alert team, and they are told that their computer systems have been hacked. Each team is presented with a fully computerised crate and are told they must solve every puzzle inside the crate in order to quarantine the virus within 90 minutes. As puzzles are successfully solved, hidden drawers inside the crate automatically open and present the team with the next problem to solve. The final puzzle requires the team to enter a final code into the Red Alert Sphere and stop the countdown.

## Learning outcomes

Red Alert is an enthralling experiential learning game that enhances teamwork and problem-solving skills in a fun and engaging environment. Teams apply creative thinking skills and effective communication as they decide on the best strategy to solve each puzzle. As the game progresses, team members learn to work better together and appreciate each other's abilities, realising that their individual talents impact on the effectiveness of their team. In the closing moments of the game, teams break from the silo mentality as they collaborate to assist other teams for the benefit of the whole group.
